Children's Hospital Needs, Blankets

Blankets are used in a variety of places and sizes throughout the NICU. They are used by mothers holding their babies and also in the bereavement room.

Fabric Requirements:

All blankets are made of soft cotton material, mostly flannel. The colors have to be infant and soft pastels. A variety of sizes is being used: 25" square, 34" square. The smallest size useable is 26" x 19". The finishing of the edges can be done with a tight serger stitch or a fold in hem. Please topstitch the fold in hem with a tight stitch.

The blankets are washed in commercial grade washing machines so there will be very vigorous washing involved. That is the reason that I recommend pre-washing the fabrics at a high temperature to make sure that they are preshrunk and hold up well. I also suggest a 1/2" seam allowance so items do not come apart at the seams.

The designs look like this. Please note that the pictures are not to scale.

Cut 26" square (25" square finished size)

Cut 35" square (24" square finished size)

Cut 27" x 20" (26" x 19" finished size)
