

Children's Hospital Needs, Isolette (Infant Incubator) Covers

Isolette (infant incubator) covers are covers that lay on the top of the Isolette. They are there to darken the Isolette and make it feel like a womb for the baby. Isolette covers are held in place on the plastic top by 2 large button holes that slide over two short plastic pipes. Please note that not all Isolettes are the same so you need to check with the hospital what size they need.

Fabric Requirements:

The bottom fabric must be dark to recreate the sense of a womb-like environment and flannel because it's less slippery than cotton. The top can be any design or color and can be regular cotton. The covers are washed in commercial grade washing machines so there will be very vigorous washing involved. That is the reason that I recommend pre-washing the fabrics at a high temperature to make sure that they are preshrunk and hold up well. I also suggest a 1/2" seam allowance so items do not come apart at the seams. The design looks like this. Please note that this picture is not to scale.
